NTRODUCTION



ARE THESE THE RIGHT GOALS FOR HOUSING?

GOALS	OUTCOMES WE WANT TO SEE:		
MORE AVAILABILITY AND CHOICE OF HOUSING	 A sufficient supply of affordable housing (rental and owner-occupied) to meet demand, across the district. Sufficient social housing to meet local demand. The most vulnerable members of society are housed safely, fewer people are living in motels and the need for emergency and transitional housing has been significantly reduced. There are effective partnerships across sectors, and between organisations delivering housing solutions. 		
HOMES ARE WARM, HEALTHY AND SUSTAINABLE	 Community housing providers are active in the district. More homes are safe and secure. More homes are warm, dry, and energy-efficient. No families living in unhealthy housing. People are supported to maintain their homes to healthy standards. 		
OUR HOMES MEET THE DIVERSE NEEDS OF OUR COMMUNITIES	 More availability and choice of housing for elderly and people with disabilities. More papakāinga enabled. More Māori land developed for housing. More homes are universally designed. 		
OUR HOUSING CONTRIBUTES TO CONNECTED AND INTEGRATED COMMUNITIES	 Housing supports connected communities and better placemaking. Housing is appropriately located and supports the wellbeing of our communities. Affordable and social housing is not concentrated in one neighbourhood. Suitable infrastructure exists to keep up with the growth. Sufficient open space and community green space to support increasing residential density.
