T-Primary causes that will trigger the Incident
C- Preventative Controls in place reducing triggering of the Event

T1- GLC is a public space - theatre
BWO of 358 pax

C Private Event by registration —
capped at 200pax and seated

T 2- Waiata Group have booked the
east end of GLC

C2 – GLC can physically separate
the events internally with barriers

T3 - Anybody pro or stop co-
governance has ability to register

C3 – Potentially the Halt Co-
governance organisers could refuse
registration if obvious a protestor –
Private Event

T4 - Inability to control who is outside
the GLC

C4- -Police and Security could have a
presence – Police indicated they
won't and Senjo have declined

T5- Inhibit of Freedom of Speech
C5 Legislation -Bill of Rights Act

T6 National interest from media coverage of tour to date
C6 No effective control (organiser feels it is media Hype)

T7- Local identities have indicated a presence
C7 Police have spoken directly with entities to reinforce passive protest – no unlawful activities

T8- Regional interest with potential of >1000 protestors – Herald **dated**
C8 Police numbers – not adequately resourced for Taupō
Security declined to provide services -21/04/23

F Reputational Damage to TDC



T9 Loss of control of numbers attending
C9 Private seated function -capped at 200 -right of refusal to enter theatre
- GLC can cordon area to theatre from Waiata group

T10 Protestors numbers outweigh the attendees
C10 Recommendation by police to increase security personnel to 10
Capping at 200 - 4 would be sufficient supported by SCG volunteers

T11 Inadequate Security Plan by organiser
- No clear roles and responsibilities
- No clear escalation process in Security Plan

C11 - TDC provided Security plan guidelines
- Plan to be independently assessed
- Police indicated will not review of security plan
Medium Risk event requirement to have Security on site

Inadequate Security

T12 -GLC Event staff are not security – just custodians
No Internal procedures in place for escalations of aggression other than relying on Security presence and escalation to police

C12 -Minimal staff present at the event – only TDC management
GLC will provide Fire & Earthquake Evacuation Plan to organiser. (First Aid)

T13 Limited powers in a public space to trespass or remove personnel as opposed to a private venue

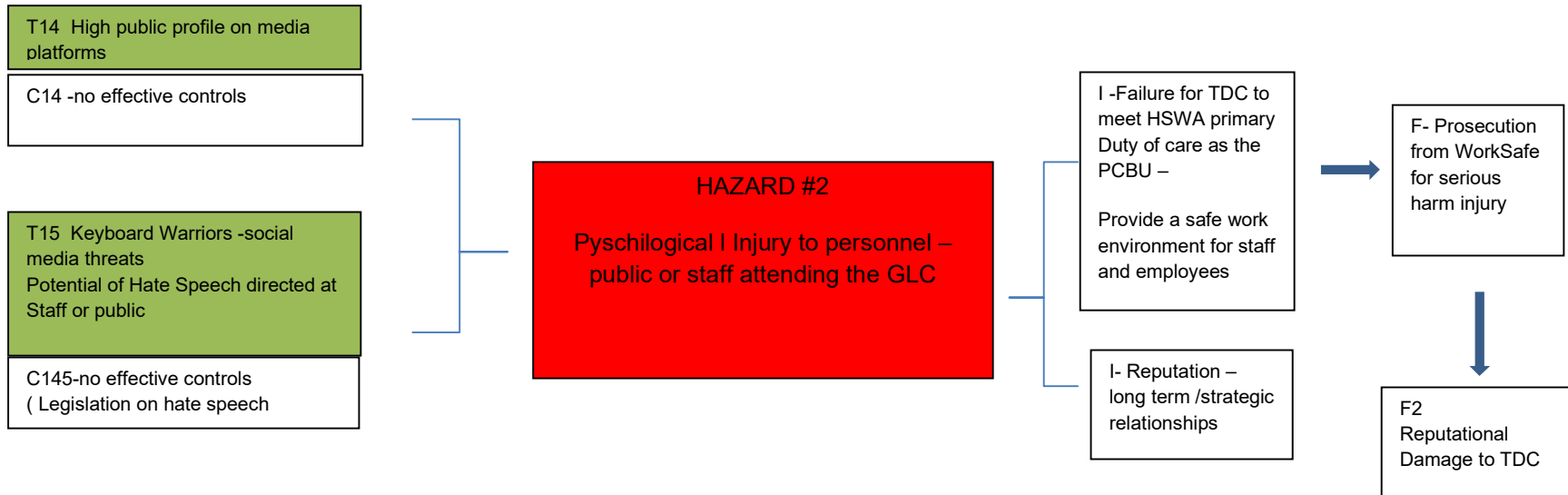
