Notice of Renewal of Club Licence

Section 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

To: Taupo Cosmopolitan Club Incorporated

Licence 20/CL/0020/2024 replacing licence 20/CL/0020/2021

The Club Licence in respect of the premises situated at 5 Taniwha Street, Taupo known as "Taupo Cosmopolitan Club" is renewed.

The present conditions of the licence shall continue to apply.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, the licence continues in force—

- until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

The period for which the licence is renewed is 3 years expiring on 12 July 2027

CLUB LICENCE

Sections 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 <u>TAUPO COSMOPOLITAN CLUB INCORPORATED</u> is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at **5 Taniwha Street**, **Taupo** and known as **Taupo Cosmopolitan Club**, for consumption on the premises, to any person who-

- a) is a member of the club; or
- b) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or
- c) is a member of some other club with which the club has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members; or
- d) is on the premises at the invitation of an authorised visitor who is also on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the club in accordance with Sub-Part 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: **Monday to Sunday from** 9.00am to 1.00am the following day.
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
- 5. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- 6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
- 7. Whilst the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no "Bring your Own" BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
- 8. The Club must display:
 - a. At every point-of-sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read so as to be easily read by persons using the premises.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The sale, supply or consumption of alcohol is authorised in the premises generally including the outdoor areas. The premises situated at 5 Taniwha Street, Taupo, are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 24th May 2024.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCES

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the club. The entrance from the carpark located off Taniwha Street, Taupo is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force –

- a) until the close of the period for which it is renewed; or
- b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before it would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it is renewed.

This licence expires on 12 July 2027 unless further renewed
