**The Application**

This is an application by Loop Live Limited for an on site Special Licence pursuant to Section 138 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 for the L.A.B, Stan Walker & Friends. It was formally received by the Taupō District Licensing Committee on 13 August 2024.

**Reasons for the Decision**

The applicant appears to be a responsible entity to hold a Special Licence, and certificated managers will oversee the sale, supply and consumption of alcohol.

We congratulate the applicant and the agencies for working constructively together and coming up with a recommended suite of discretionary conditions including service size, product ranges and food outlets.

We expect the applicant to make good his assurances to the agencies,


The Police and Medical Officer of Health reports raise no final matters in opposition.

**The Decision**

## On Site Special Licence

*Section 22 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Loop Live Limited** is authorised to sell and supply alcohol, on the premises situated at 11 Redoubt Street, Taupo and known as Taupō Amphitheatre & Riverside Park for consumption on the premises, to any person attending the following occasion or event (or series of occasions or events): **L.A.B, Stan Walker & Friends.**

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a managers or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:  
**Saturday 18 January 2025 from 3.00pm to 10.00pm.**  
**The bar will close at 7.45pm, and only those in the queue will be served, with the bar sales to cease at 8.15pm.**  
**The special licence for the entire venue will operate until 10.00pm.**
2. Alcohol serves: A maximum of four alcoholic drinks can be sold to any one person at any one time from 3:00pm to 4:30pm. A maximum of two alcoholic drinks can be sold to any one person at any one time from 4.30pm to 6.15pm. A maximum of one alcoholic drink can be sold to any one person at any one time from 6.15pm to 8.15pm.
3. All canned alcohol products will be depressurised at the point of sale. All bottled products will be poured into plastic cups at the point of sale.
4. Police have the ability to require further reduction of alcohol service sizes, or a shift to low alcohol beverages, or to request a closure of all, or any bar, at any time based on intoxication levels and/ or crowd behaviour. Any request will be evidence based on review meetings with the licensee and any of the Taupo Alcohol Licensing Inspectorate, or the Medical Officer of Health Representative.
5. Those entering the U18 area will not be permitted to pass out and back into the general admission area.
6. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
7. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed.
8. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence, or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
9. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
10. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
  - a. At every point-of-sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons,
  - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises,
  - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty,
  - d. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.

### DURATION

This licence is only in force as specified in Condition 1.

### THE LICENSED PREMISES

The licensed premises known as L.A.B., Stan Walker & Friends, situated at Taupo Amphitheatre & Riverside Park, 11 Redoubt Street, Taupo, is more precisely identified as outlined in the event site plans provided with the application as received by the Taupo District Licensing Committee on 13 August 2024 and 24 October 2024.
