# **GO PREPARED**

- At a minimum, you'll want to have proper clothing and footwear, gloves, and rubbish bags.
- I can provide gloves and bags if you need them!
- HiViz vests and litter pickers are also helpful to have.

### **PICK A LOCATION**

- Students should stay near an adult and off the roads at all times.
- If there's anything you're uncomfortable picking up (e.g. needles), or looks toxic or unhygienic, please err on the side of caution and leave it.

- Competition entries must be submitted by 5pm on Friday 4 October. Winners will be selected and notified by Friday 11 October.
- Five prize winners will be chosen based on merit to receive a prize from the following:
  - 1. Largest litter weight collected: \$200 Mitre 10 MEGA gift card sponsored by Mitre 10 MEGA
  - 2. Largest area covered: Sausage Sizzle sponsored by Taupō District Council
